

Scholarships available for HR conference registration

Blazing the Trail: Human Resource Conference for Local Government will be held April 21-22 in Bismarck at the Ramkota Hotel. This statewide HR conference, the first designed specifically for local government, is hosted by the HR Collaborative Partners for Local Government: ND Recreation & Park Association (NDRPA), ND Association of Counties (NDACo), ND League of Cities, ND School Boards Association, and ND Insurance Reserve Fund (NDIRF).

Through support from NDIRF, NDRPA is pleased to offer 60 scholarships for members to attend the conference! NDRPA agency members are eligible for up to five scholarships each to cover the conference registration fee (\$75 per person) through March 1 on a first-come, first-served basis. After that date, any remaining funds will be available to members who have already received five scholarships but wish to send more than five staff or board members to the conference. All scholarship requests and registration forms/confirmations must be received by 5 p.m. CST April 2.

Scholarship Requests

Because NDACo is managing conference registrations and only NDRPA members are eligible for the scholarship, there is no scholarship check box on the conference registration form. Therefore, there are two options to receive a scholarship:

1. Register online
 - Register online at www.ndrpa.com
 - When you receive the confirmation email from NDACo, forward the email to Dana at clearfour@btinet.net and note "scholarship request"
2. Register by mail or fax
 - Complete the registration form
 - Write "scholarship request" at the top of the form
 - Mail the form to: NDRPA, PO Box 1091, Bismarck, ND 58502 OR fax to: 701-223-4645

Scholarship Notification

You will be notified when your scholarship request has been received and awarded. If you are awarded a scholarship, NDRPA will pay your registration fee directly to the HR conference.

If your agency submits more than five scholarship requests, the requests will be placed on a waiting list to be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis after March 1.
